Naomi: A Godly Mother

- A Covenant Heart
 - The Book of Ruth She was a mother to someone that wasn't even her blood
- Proactive- She didn't sit idle; but produced for her family
 - Rut 1:6-7 (NASB) Then she arose with her daughters-in-law that she might return from the land of Moab, for she had heard in the land of Moab that the LORD had visited His people in giving them food. 7 So she departed from the place where she was, and her two daughters-in-law with her; and they went on the way to return to the land of Judah.

Unselfish

Rut 1:8-9 (NASB) And Naomi said to her two daughters-in-law, "Go, return each of you to her mother's house. May the LORD deal kindly with you as you have dealt with the dead and with me. 9 "May the LORD grant that you may find rest, each in the house of her husband." Then she kissed them, and they lifted up their voices and wept.

Doesn't Overuse Authority

Rut 1:18 (NASB) When she saw that she was determined to go with her, she said no more to her.

A Confirming Voice

 Rut 2:22 (NASB) Naomi said to Ruth her daughter-in-law, "It is good, my daughter, that you go out with his maids, so that others do not fall upon you in another field."

Facilitates Provision

• Rut 3:1 (NASB) Then Naomi her mother-in-law said to her, "My daughter, shall I not seek security for you, that it may be well with you?

Wise & Sharing Wisdom

Rut 3:2-4 (NASB) "Now is not Boaz our kinsman, with whose maids you were? Behold, he winnows barely at the threshing floor tonight. 3 "Wash yourself therefore, and anoint yourself and put on your best clothes, and go down to the threshing floor; but do not make yourself known to the man until he has finished eating and drinking. 4 "It shall be when he lies down, that you shall notice the place where he lies, and you shall go and uncover his feet and lie down; then he will tell you what you shall do."

Receives Redemption

Rut 4:13-15 (NASB) So Boaz took Ruth, and she became his wife, and he went in to her. And the LORD enabled her to conceive, and she gave birth to a son. 14 Then the women said to Naomi, "Blessed is the LORD who has not left you without a redeemer today, and may his name become famous in Israel. 15 "May he also be to you a restorer of life and a sustainer of your old age; for your daughter-in-law, who loves you and is better to you than seven sons, has given birth to him."

Fulfills Her Destiny

• Rut 4:16-17 (NASB) Then Naomi took the child and laid him in her lap, and became his nurse. 17 The neighbor women gave him a name, saying, "A son has been born to Naomi!" So they named him Obed. He is the father of Jesse, the father of David.
