Come

Matthew 11:28-30 (NAS95)

28 "**COME** to Me, all who are weary and heavy-laden, and I will give you rest.

29 "Take My yoke upon you and learn from Me, for I am gentle and humble in heart, and YOU WILL FIND REST FOR YOUR SOULS.

30 "For My yoke is easy and My burden is light."

James 4:6-10 (NAS95)

6 But **He gives** a **greater grace**. Therefore *it* says, "GOD IS OPPOSED TO THE PROUD, BUT GIVES GRACE TO THE **HUMBLE**."

7 **Submit therefore to God**. Resist the devil and he will flee from you.

8 **Draw near to God** and He will draw near to you. Cleanse your hands, you sinners; and purify your hearts, you double-minded.

9 Be miserable and mourn and weep; let your laughter be turned into mourning and your joy to gloom.

10 **Humble yourselves in the presence of the Lord**, and He will exalt you.

Hebrews 10:25 (NLT) And let us not neglect **our meeting together**, as some people do, but encourage one another, especially now that the day of his return is drawing near.

Hebrews 4:14-16 (NAS95)

14 Therefore, since we have a great high priest who has passed through the heavens, Jesus the Son of God, let us hold fast our confession.

15 For we do not have a high priest who cannot sympathize with our weaknesses, but One who has been tempted in all things as *we are*, yet without sin.

16 Therefore let us **draw near** with confidence to the throne of grace, so that we may receive mercy and find grace to help in time of need.

Call

Acts 2:21 (NAS95) 'AND IT SHALL BE THAT EVERYONE WHO CALLS ON THE NAME OF THE LORD WILL BE SAVED.'

Psalms 50:15 (NASB) Call upon Me in the day of trouble; I shall rescue you, and you will honor Me."

Jeremiah 33:3 (NASB) 'Call to Me and I will answer you, and I will tell you great and mighty things, which you do not know.'

James 5:14-16 (NAS95)

14 Is anyone among you sick? **Then he must call for the elders of the church** and they are to pray over him, anointing him with oil in the name of the Lord;

15 and the prayer offered in **faith will restore** the one who is sick, and the Lord will raise him up, and if he has committed sins, they will be forgiven him.

16 Therefore, confess your sins to one another, and pray for one another so that you may be healed. The effective prayer of a righteous man can accomplish much.

Even Jesus came to the Father:

- 12 years old at the temple
- EVEN Jesus went to be baptized by God's man
- Went to fellowship in the wilderness
- Called on the Father in prayer in the garden

Hebrews 13:17 (NAS95) Obey your leaders and **submit** to them, for they keep watch over your souls as those who will give an account. Let them do this with joy and not with grief, for this would be unprofitable for you.

1 Peter 5:1-3 (NAS95)

1 Therefore, I exhort the elders among you, as *your* fellow elder and witness of the sufferings of Christ, and a partaker also of the glory that is to be revealed,

2 shepherd the flock of God among you, exercising oversight not under compulsion, but voluntarily, according to *the will of God*; and not for sordid gain, but with eagerness;

3 nor yet as lording it over those allotted to your charge, but proving to be examples to the flock.

Coming to your leaders in Christ is coming to Him

Ephesians 4:8, 11-16 (NASB)

8 Therefore it says, "WHEN HE ASCENDED ON HIGH, HE LED CAPTIVE A HOST OF CAPTIVES, AND HE GAVE GIFTS TO MEN."

11 And He gave some as apostles, and some as prophets, and some as evangelists, and some as pastors and teachers,

12 for the equipping of the saints for the work of service, to the building up of the body of Christ;

13 until we all attain to the unity of the faith, and of the knowledge of the Son of God, to a mature man, to the measure of the stature which belongs to the fullness of Christ.

14 As a result, we are no longer to be children, tossed here and there by waves and carried about by every wind of doctrine, by the trickery of men, by craftiness in deceitful scheming;

15 but speaking the truth in love, we are to grow up in all *aspects* into Him who is the head, *even* Christ,

16 from whom the whole body, being fitted and held together by what every joint supplies, according to the proper working of each individual part, causes the growth of the body for the building up of itself in love.

Coming to Him & Calling on Him in your offerings

- EVERY future is sick with poverty without a seed planted to bring up the future harvest.
- We need to call on a harvest in every meeting with our seed

2 Corinthians 9:6 (NASB) Now this / say, he who sows sparingly will also reap sparingly, and he who sows bountifully will also reap bountifully.

2 Corinthians 9:6 (YLT) And this: He who is sowing sparingly, sparingly also shall reap; and he who is sowing in blessings, in blessings also shall reap;
