

Resurrection Blessings!

Romans 6:21-23 (NLT)

21 And what was the result? You are now ashamed of the things you used to do, things that end in eternal doom.

22 But now you are free from the power of sin and have become slaves of God. Now you do those things that lead to holiness and result in eternal life.

23 For the wages of sin is death, but the free gift of God is eternal life through Christ Jesus our Lord.

John 3:16-17 (NASB)

16 "For God so loved the world, that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him shall not perish, but have eternal life.

17 "For God did not send the Son into the world to judge the world, but that the world might be saved through Him.

After sin, death and lack start going to work.

Example of Adam

James 2:10 (NASB) For whoever keeps the whole law and yet stumbles in one *point*, he has become guilty of all.

After one sin, we cannot help ourselves.

Sin disqualifies us to make it right.

BUT God is holy & cannot be unholy.

Because we cannot help ourselves, we are classified as sinners and even enemies of God's holiness.

BUT we have GREAT NEWS!

Romans 5:5-11 (NASB)

5 and hope does not disappoint, because the love of God has been poured out within our hearts through the Holy Spirit who was given to us.

6 For while we were still helpless, at the right time Christ died for the ungodly.

7 For one will hardly die for a righteous man; though perhaps for the good man someone would dare even to die.

8 But God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us.

9 Much more then, having now been justified by His blood, we shall be saved from the wrath of God through Him.

10 For if while we were enemies we were reconciled to God through the death of His Son, much more, having been reconciled, we shall be saved by His life.

11 And not only this, but we also exult in God through our Lord Jesus Christ, through whom we have now received the reconciliation.

- When Jesus took our sin on Him He Had to pay the wages of death & lack
- He had to shed His blood.

Leviticus 17:11 (NASB) 'For the life of the flesh is in the blood, and I have given it to you on the altar to make atonement for your souls; for it is the blood by reason of the life that makes atonement.'

Matthew 26:27-28 (NASB)

27 And when He had taken a cup and given thanks, He gave *it* to them, saying, "Drink from it, all of you;

28 for this is My blood of the covenant, which is poured out for many for forgiveness of sins.

Romans 10:9-10 (NASB)

9 that if you confess with your mouth Jesus as Lord, and believe in your heart that God raised Him from the dead, you will be saved;

10 for with the heart a person believes, resulting in righteousness, and with the mouth he confesses, resulting in salvation.

I often wondered why it was important to believe that Jesus was physically raised from the dead

Because the wages of sin is death, there was no possible way for him to be resurrected, unless the wages had been totally paid for all of mankind!

When we believe that He is risen, we believe that we are totally forgiven, blessed and free forever!

When I Need:

- Forgiveness for my mess ups and sin, He has already paid the price!
- Help for my shortcomings & lack, He has already released the grace and faith to overcome!
- Peace that doesn't make sense, the piece that passes understanding, He has already given me the fruit of the Holy Ghost!
- Joy for morning times & everyday life in a corrupted world, He has already given me a mantle of praise!
- My loving father in my life, I now have intimate fellowship available!
- Healing in my body, it has been paid for already!
- Finances, He has already taken the poverty and destroyed it!
- Supernatural protection, it has already been released for me!
- To be restored, He has already released the anointing to heal my past!
- To be delivered from trouble, He is already released the Holy Spirit of TOTAL freedom!
