

“What Kind Of Man Is This”

The God-Kind of Man

Matthew 8:24–27

- Vs 24: And behold, a great storm arose on the sea, so that the boat was being covered with the waves; but Jesus Himself was asleep.
- Vs 25: And they came to Him and woke Him, saying, “Save us, Lord; we are perishing!”
- Vs 26: He said to them, “Why are you afraid, you men of little faith?” Then He got up and rebuked the winds and the sea, and it became perfectly calm.
- Vs 27: The men were amazed, and said, “**What kind of man is this**, that even the winds and the sea obey Him?”

Fruit of the “THIS KIND OF MAN”

Matthew 7:28–29

- Vs 28: When Jesus had finished these words, *the crowds were amazed* at His teaching;
- Vs 29: for He was teaching them as one having authority, and **not as their scribes**.

Mark 1:22, 27

- Vs 22: *They were amazed at His teaching*; for He was teaching them as one having authority, and **not as the scribes**.
- Vs 27: *They were all amazed*, so that they debated among themselves, saying, “**What is this?** A new teaching with authority! He commands even the unclean spirits, and they obey Him.”

Luke 4:32, 36

- Vs 32: *They were amazed at His teaching*, for His message was with authority.
- Vs 36: *Amazement came upon them all*, and they began talking with one another, saying, “What is this message? **For with authority and power He commands the unclean spirits, and they come out.**”

The Kind of man Jesus is produces this kind of reality:

1. The God-kind of living
2. A man with the God-kind of faith
3. A man of power and authority
4. A righteous man
5. Creation listened to Him
 - Fish (Luke 5)
 - Tree (Mark 11)
 - Sea (Matt 8)
1. Demons listened and submitted
2. Sickness and disease healed
3. Dead Raised
4. He entered dark places and set people free
5. Prosperity manifested
6. Oppression broken off people

Scripture says He is the firstborn among many brethren”, then that means you and I—having received Him—have been made like Him.

Romans 8:29 : Conformed to the image of His Son, so that Jesus would be the firstborn among many brethren

- We are conformed into who/what He is!

Romans 8:29: YLT “because He did foreknow, He also did for-appoint, **Conformed to the image of His Son**, that He might be the first born of many brethren.

- “Conformed” means:
 - * Having the same form as another
 - * To be fashioned alike
- 2 Corinthians 5:17 – A new creation
 - He didn’t just improve who we were—He gave us who He is, made a brand new creation
 - Jesus on the cross took who we were, so by His resurrection we could be who He is...
 - ✦ We are the same kind as Jesus.

So if He had dominion over all these things as a man, then we too have dominion over them as men.

In fact, because of what He did, we are not just ordinary men—but the same kind of man He is.

- 1 John 4:17 – “By this, love is perfected with us, so that we may have confidence in the day of judgment; because **as He is, so are we in this world.**”

- * It doesn’t say “as He was”...

- * We are to operate in this world as He **is now**, not as He was.

- * The kind of man we are is the kind of man Jesus is.

- * See Revelation 1:10–16

Steps to Walk in This Reality:

1. Receive Christ – Become a new creation (2 Corinthians 5:17)
2. Renew your mind – Be conformed to His image (Romans 8:29)
3. Know your identity – You are like Him
4. Exercise authority – Speak and act like Jesus
5. Walk in righteousness – Live out who you truly are
6. Expect results – Creation and darkness respond
7. Live as He is – Not as He was, but as He is now (1 John 4:17)
