

Walk as Jesus Walked

1 John 1:6

- If we say we have fellowship with Him and yet walk in the darkness, we lie and do not practice the truth.

1 John 2:6

- The one who says he abides in Him ought himself to walk in the **same manner** as He walked.

God told me to study out 3 words:

- Live, Walk, Practice

Live by:

- Habakkuk 2:4
 - Romans 1:17
 - Hebrews 10:38
 - Galatians 3:11:
 - Now that no one is justified by the law before God is evident; For, THE RIGHTEOUS MAN SHALL **LIVE BY FAITH**.

Walk by/walk as

- 2 Corinthians 5:7 "for we **walk** by faith, not by sight.
 - Galatians 5:16,25
 - 16: **WALK** by the Spirit.
 - 25: let us also **WALK** by the Spirit.
 - 1 John 2:6: **walk** as Jesus walked.
 - Ephesians 5:2: **walk** in love, just as Christ also loved you.
 - 3 John 1:4: my children **WALKING** in the truth.

Practice

- 1 John 3:4 Everyone who practices sin also **practices** lawlessness.
 - 1 John 3:7 The one who **practices** righteousness is righteous.

Question God asked:

- What made you so good at football?
 - What made you so good at being a Marine?

What we **LIVE BY**, we will **WALK BY**, and what we walk by, we will **PRACTICE**.

- What we **live** by determines how we **walk**, and how we **walk** determines what we **practice**.

Live: Source, flow of what we walk.

Walk: daily conduct, what we are disciplined by.

Practice: pattern in which we follow.

Ephesians 2:1-2

- 1 and you were dead in your trespasses and sins,
 - 2 in which you FORMERLY **walked** *according to the course of this world*, **according** to the **prince of the air** of the spirit that is now working in the sons of disobedience

Colossians 3:6-7,9

- 6 "For it is because of these things that the wrath of God will come upon the sons of disobedience,
 - 7 and in them you also once **walked**, when you were **living** in them."
 - Vs 9 "Do not lie to one another, since you laid aside the old self with its evil **practices**,"

Galatians 3:11-12

- 11 "Now that no one is justified by the Law before God is evident; for, "The righteous man shall live by faith."
 - 12 However, the Law is not of faith; on the contrary, "He who practices them shall live by them."
 - The law was given for them to walk out the practice of the law.
 - ◆ Walk: day by day **conduct**/ step by step direction/ direction of life
 - ◆ Practice: repeated action/habitual **pattern**/what you consistently do
